Recover worked with One Canal Apartment Group and Copley Wolff Design Group to remediate two green roofs on a multiuse building located at Boston's Rose Kennedy Greenway. The existing third-floor terrace and 13th-floor pool deck had seen massive plant die-offs due to an irrigation failure that left plants without watering for an extended period. The plantings on the pool deck had also seen extensive damaged from high winds that resulted in wind scour and soil erosion.

As part of the remediation, Recover's field crew installed a new irrigation system in mounded beds and replaced multiple sections of irrigation across the two roofs. After initial updates, Recover replanted about 95% of the roofs. The green roofs have now been restored to their original intention, providing habitat for birds, stormwater retention, and aesthetic appeal for building residents.

Post-remediation, Recover manages maintenance to insure dynamic plant care and a healthy green roof for years to come.
