Bringing community members together around art, music, and food, Sally's Rooftop Garden, and the surrounding 3,000 sq. ft. of activity space, serves as an event and education venue for the Kranzberg Art Foundation's .ZACK location, a renovated multi-use arts building in downtown St. Louis.

Recover installed **Aerated Media Modules (RAMMs)** with an integrated SMART irrigation system allowing for flexibility and mobility in design, while also maximizing vegetable production in the minimal available growing space. The garden, managed by Urban Harvest STL, supports a variety of vegetables, fruits, herbs, and edible flowers. A portion of the produce is used for Foundation events, while the rest is donated to local non-profit partners that serve communities with limited access to fresh produce and healthy food.
